RAINBOW FISH BOOKMARK

REQUIRES ASSISTANCE FROM AN ADULT

Draw a fish on a sheet of white paper. Ask an adult to cut out your fish drawing. Place the fish shape on the blue felt and ask an adult to use your fish drawing as a stencil to cut the blue felt into the same fish shape. Cut the fabric remnants into "scales" for the fish and use the yellow fabric to cut out the "mouth" of the fish.

Ask an adult to cut two equal, right-angle triangles out of the cardboard, making sure that the two right angles are the same size.

Finally, ask an adult to sew or staple together the two sides that form the right angles so they can fit onto the corner of a page in a book.

Glue the blue felt fish onto the two joined-together triangles, then glue the scales onto the fish and decorate the fish with sequins. Glue on the googly eye and the yellow mouth.

When the fish are nicely dried, you can use it as a bookmark.
